



Peoples Bank Theatre opens its Summer-Fall Season with the return of Travis Tritt, whose solo acoustic performance was part of the theatre's grand reopening in January 2016. This time, Tritt returns with his full band, just after celebrating his 25th Anniversary with the Grand Ole Opry.

More than 25 years after Tritt launched his music career, the Grammy award-winning artist continues to sell-out shows across the globe. A Marietta, Georgia native, Travis Tritt is dubbed one of "The Class of '89," which included Country music superstars Garth Brooks, Clint Black and Alan Jackson; all of whom dominated the charts in the early 1990s. Among his eleven studio albums and numerous charted singles are nineteen Top 10 hits, including "Modern Day Bonnie and Clyde," "Here's A Quarter" and "It's A Great Day To Be Alive." Over the course of his career, he has amassed more than 25 million career album sales, two Grammy award wins and multiple No. 1 singles on the Country radio charts. Most recently, Tritt released a special live 2-disc CD and DVD, titled "A Man and His Guitar – Live From The Franklin Theatre."





Purchasing Tickets

Ticket orders may be placed online at peoplesbanktheatre.com, by phone at 740-371-5152 or in person at the Peoples Bank Theatre Box Office from 10AM–4PM Monday through Friday. Members and Seat Sponsors receive advance ticket ordering privileges.

Seating for children

Generally, every person over the age of 2 years old must have a ticket. Occasionally, shows may require tickets for everyone regardless of age. Any child attending a performance should be able to sit quietly through the show. As a courtesy to other audience members, please use discretion in bringing a young child to performances. For questions, please contact the Box Office.

Will Call

The Will Call window is located at the Putnam Street Box Office. Will call generally opens one hour prior to the performance unless otherwise stated. In order to pick up tickets at will call you will need to present a valid photo ID (drivers license or passport). Box Office staff may also request to see the credit card used to purchase the tickets as an alternative or secondary form of verification. The box office staff will not release tickets if the name on the ID or credit card does not match the name given at the time of purchase.

Refunds, exchanges, and cancellations All sales are final. There are no refunds or exchanges unless otherwise noted. In the event a performance is canceled or postponed, the Peoples Bank Theatre Box Office staff will notify patrons as to the options available.

Ticket fees

Ticket fees are charged and are included in the advertised ticket price for events produced by the theatre. Outside promoters and renters may have ticket fees in addition to the advertised price. Ticket fees cover historic preservation and the costs of operating a box office, including staffing, software licensing, etc.

Services for patrons with disabilities Peoples Bank Theatre offers accessible seating on the auditorium level, accessible public restroom facilities, assistive listening devices, and sign language interpretation (when requested at least two weeks in advance).

Recording devices

Cameras, camera phones, audio and digital recorders, paging devices and cell phones may not be permitted in the theatre based on the artist's policies. Guests using prohibited devices may be ejected from the theatre without refund.

Late seating policy

Each individual show's producer or artist determines the seating policy for late arriving guests. In some instances, if you arrive after the show begins, you may be asked to wait until there is a natural break in the act before going to your seat.

If you need assistance or have a question, please ask a Peoples Bank Theatre volunteer. They will be happy to help you.






